Introduction To Tourist Attractions



The Xiaowulai Route connects the famous tourist attractions of the Northern Cross-island Highway in series, including the Daxi Old Street, Cihu, Jiaobanshan, New Xikou Suspension Bridge, and Xiaowulai Skywalk. Along the route, there are diverse sightseeing experiences such as waterfalls, hiking trails, plum farms, and indigenous tribal culture. By taking this route, visitors can explore popular attractions in Taoyuan.

6 DAXI OLD STREET



Daxi Old Street

The main area encompasses three historical streets: Heping Road, Zhongshan Road, and Zhongyuan Road. The architectural style showcases predominantly Baroque facades, full of cultural and historical charm.



Daxi Bridge

With a total length of approximately 570 meters, Daxi Bridge spans across the upper reaches of the Dahan River. It offers beautiful scenery and magnificent views, making it one of the famous attractions in Daxi. The bridge features a pedestrian walkway, and in the evening, it is illuminated, adding to its grandeur.

7 DAXI STATION



Daxi Wood Art Ecomuseum

The Ecomuseum consists of eleven main buildings, including Hall No.1, Wude Hall, Native History Hall, Craftsman Story House, Li Teng-Fang's Old Mansion, Wooden Furniture Hall, Wood Lifestyle Hall, June 24 Story House, Arts & Crafts Exchange Hall, Arts & Crafts Center (including residency space), and the Feng Fei-Fei Story House. All of these buildings are open for free visits.

9 DAXI MAUSOLEUM



Daxi Mausoleum

Originally known as the "Touliao Guesthouse", the Daxi Mausoleum is a down-to-earth modest courtyard dwelling (Siheyuan). After the passing of the late President Chiang Ching-Kuo, it was renamed "Daxi Mausoleum" and served as his resting place. The interior of the Mausoleum consists only of Chiang Ching-Kuo's Memorial Hall and an office.

12 NANGOU · OLD BAIJI TUNNEL



OLD BAIJI TUNNEL

This tunnel, which has been closed and reopened twice, was transformed into a tourist trail in 2007. Inside the tunnel, visitors can see the light railway built during the Japanese colonial period and the "Taiwanese Push Cart" (also known as the "Taiwanese Bamboo Train"), which represents that era. The old tunnel connects to other ancient trails such as the Governor-General's Trail and the Baiji Forest Trail, making it a great addition to your itinerary.

14 KZYAY · DAXI TEA FACTORY



DAXI TEA FACTORY

Designed based on the blueprint of the Darjeeling Tea Factory in India, the Daxi Old Tea Factory showcases a blend of Taiwanese and Japanese architectural styles, reflecting a diverse cultural influence. The main color tone of the building is blue, whether it is the window lattice and beam-column, the shaped shelves, the walls, the art paintings, and so on. The low-key blue-toned fit exceptionally well with this brick building mixed with the cypress roof frame of the tea factory.

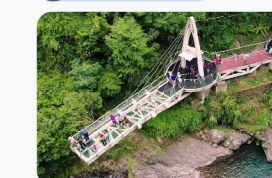
15 JIAOBANSHAN PARK



Jiaobanshan Visitor Center

The Jiaobanshan Visitor Center offers various attractions within its premises, including the War Preparedness Tunnel, the Guesthouses of Chiang Kai-shek, Sculpture Park, and Camphor Collection Depot and others. While the military ambiance has faded, it has become a place for visitors to reminisce about battlefield scenery.

16 XIAOWULAI



Xiaowulai Skywalk

The Xiaowulai Skywalk is suspended above the Xiaowulai Waterfall. By standing on the glass platform, which is 70 meters above the base of the waterfall, visitors can enjoy a breathtaking bird's eye view of the beautiful Xiaowulai Valley, as well as the majestic waterfall landscape. It allows travelers to fulfill their dream of strolling in the clouds.



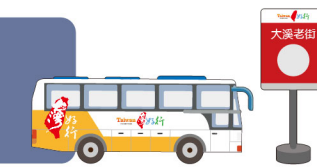
