






























It belongs to the tail end of the Xueshan Mountain Range. When viewed from Amuping in Taoyuan, the shape of the mountain resembles a reclining girl with big eyes looking towards the east, hence the name "Dongyanshan". The entire area covers nearly 1,000 hectares and boasts over 300 hectares of stunning willow tree scenery. The highest point in the area is "Dongyanshan" at an elevation of 1,212 meters, offering panoramic views of Taoyuan, Sanxia, and the Tamsui River.

Tomita Garden Farm


