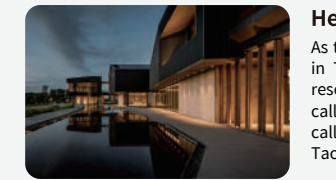


### Introduction To Tourist Attractions



The Daxi Express covers major attractions in Daxi District, Taoyuan City. It includes visiting the Baroque-style historical sites of Daxi Old Street, tasting local delicacies, engaging in hands-on activities, and enjoying the scenery and so forth, allowing visitors to fully experience the charm of Daxi from all angles.

#### 1 THSR TAOYUAN STATION



**Hengshan Calligraphy Art Center**  
 As the first official calligraphy-themed art center in Taiwan, it is dedicated to the preservation, research, development, and promotion of calligraphy art. It showcases the artistic energy of calligraphy, which is rich in cultural identity, in Taoyuan.

#### 2 METROWALK SHOPPING CENTER



**MetroWalk Shopping Center**  
 Established more than a decade ago, it is an important landmark in the Greater Taoyuan area; the exterior of the building features cast stone walls that exude a strong European charm. Its sleek and curved design breaks away from the traditional architectural image of department stores.

#### 4 CIDING · INDIGENOUS CULTURE CENTER



**Taoyuan City Indigenous Cultural Center**  
 The Indigenous Cultural Center combines the functions of a museum to showcase various indigenous traditional artifacts such as crafts, weaving tools, indigenous clothing, hunting knives, and more. Through detailed written explanations and old photographs, visitors can gain a comprehensive understanding of indigenous history.

#### 5 DAXI OLD STREET



**Daxi Old Street**  
 The main area encompasses three historical streets: Heping Road, Zhongshan Road, and Zhongyuan Road. The architectural style showcases predominantly Baroque facades, full of cultural and historical charm.



**Daxi Bridge**  
 With a total length of approximately 570 meters, Daxi Bridge spans across the upper reaches of the Dahan River. It offers beautiful scenery and magnificent views, making it one of the famous attractions in Daxi. The bridge features a pedestrian walkway, and in the evening, it is illuminated, adding to its grandeur.

#### 6 DAXI STATION



**Daxi Wood Art Ecomuseum**  
 The Ecomuseum consists of eleven main buildings, including Hall No.1, Wude Hall, Native History Hall, Craftsman Story House, Li Teng-Fang's Old Mansion, Wooden Furniture Hall, Wood Lifestyle Hall, June 24 Story House, Arts & Crafts Exchange Hall, Arts & Crafts Center (including residency space), and the Feng Fei-Fei Story House. All of these buildings are open for free visits.

#### 7 SANCENG · DATIELIAO OLD TRAIL



**Datieliao Historical Trail**  
 The trail is an approximately 5-kilometer-long ancient pathway and is renowned as one of the popular hiking routes. The ancient bridge along the trail was once an important route between Daxi and Pingxi during the Qing Dynasty. The trail offers picturesque scenery, blending harmoniously with cultural and historical features.

#### 8 Chiang Ching-kuo Memorial Hall · Beiheng Visitor Center



**Daxi Mausoleum**  
 Originally known as the "Touliao Guesthouse", the Daxi Mausoleum is a down-to-earth courtyard dwelling (Siheyuan). After the passing of the late President Chiang Ching-Kuo, it was renamed "Daxi Mausoleum" and served as his resting place. The interior of the Mausoleum consists only of Chiang Ching-Kuo's Memorial Hall and an office.



**Chiang Ching-kuo Memorial Hall (Beiheng Visitor Center)**  
 Chiang Ching-kuo Memorial Hall (Beiheng Visitor Center) is the first stop for tourists entering Beiheng Mountain Area. Not only can it provide tourists with travel information and itinerary arrangements, it can also let tourists understand the historical stories of Beiheng, especially the life of Mr. Chiang Ching-kuo and the deeds that happened in Beiheng and Taiwan.

#### 9 CAOLINGJIAO · TOMIMA GARDEN FARM



**Tomita Garden Farm**  
 The farm offers various European-style landscapes such as the Crystal Church, a castle and a huge grass lawn, providing great opportunities for Instagram-worthy photos. The farm also features adorable animals like miniature horses, musk pigs, and regular horses that visitors can feed, making it an ideal destination for family outings.

#### 10 CIHU



**Cihu Mausoleum** (front of Cihu Lake)  
 The Cihu Mausoleum is famous for being the resting place of the late President Chiang Kai-Shek. Cihu is divided into the front and back Cihu Lake, with enchanting watercolors and the beauty of the scenery similar to the areas south of the Yangtze River. Mr. Chiang chose this location because it reminded him of his hometown and named it Cihu out of his deep affection for his mother.

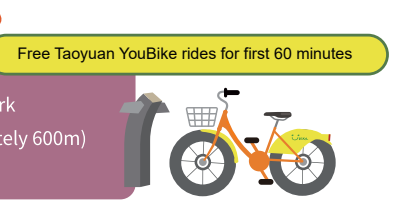
### Touring Daxi by bike
