


wood. They are the remarkable treasures in the forest of Taiwan.







Hot Attractions

Shihmen Reservoir

Exit Freeway No.3 at Longtan Interchange and continue on the Tai-113th Highway. Through Longtan to the Shihmen Reservoir.

A connection hub branching out to more than a dozen scenic spots including the dam, Maple Park, Nan-Yuan ecological park, and it is well-equipped with a bike lane and round-the-lake cruise trip services. During the monsoon, whenever the mighty dam unleashes its impounded force, the

outpouring of the flood always draws a big swarm of people to view the scene. In addition, the local characteristic, the jumping fish cuisine in the local restaurants is tasty and deserves a try.

Shihmen Dam

Bordering Longtan, Daxi, and Fuxing, the Shihmen Reservoir is held by the rock filled Shihmen Dam across the Dahan Creek nearby Guanxi, Hsinchu County. Notably, it is Taiwan's first multifunctional reservoir.



Shihmen Jumping Fish

The jumping fish cuisine is the most well-known delicacy around Shihmen Dam. While in the old days, the cuisine was mainly processed in three ways: Casserole, fried with soy and chili pepper paste, and braised in soy source. New recipes have been kept popping up over time, and now, more than 200 newly developed recipes make the cuisine deserve your try.



Bicycle Joyride

Hemming around the reservoir, the Shihmen Reservoir bike lane is favored by many cyclists for its ecologically rich environment and picturesque scenery. Many find themselves refreshed by feeling the cool breeze and listening to the birds and bugs chirping in this gorgeous landscapes.



Shihmen Reservoir Pleasure Cruise

Visitors can take a yacht ride around the reservoir to fully soak up its grandeur. Every May, a sea of Tung blossoms grace the Shi-Xiu Bay. Each year from April to August, verdant grass would grow and yield a dreamlike landscape that has drawn many TV drama crews to film here.



Ginger Root Isle

Resembling the shape of a pillow, the Ginger Root Isle was originally named the Pillow Mountain. However, once the TV drama called "Destined to Be Yours" showed several scenes here and brought fame to it, Ginger Root Isle has become a new attraction.



Watching the Maple Red Leafs at Shihmen

Between autumn and winter, we invite you to see watch the red leaves of maple trees and experience the beauty of nature. Nan Garden Eco Reserve and Maple Trail are the best place to explore the beauty of the red leaves falling.



Daping Tribe

🏡 Enter from Lane 55 of Shihmen Road. It is located near the Sankeng Old Street. There are direction signs on Shihmen Road when heading for Shihmen from Taoyuan.

Walking into the Daping Tribe, the streets usually gives visitors the impression like a labyrinth. There is a century old laundry pavilion, "Wash and Clean", for housewives to hand-wash clothes in the alleys. In addition, both the Daping Village Red Bridge and Daping Riverbank Park are also well-known attractions. If you visit Taoyuan, come and get a full dose of Daping's historic charm.



Daping Village Red Bridge

🏡 Enter via alley next to No. 741, Sec. Sanlin, Zhongzheng Rd., Longtan Dist.

Daping Village Red Bridge used to be the connection between Sankengzih and Daping. Today, after the completion of the ecologically engineered riverbank park with the bridge, the area has become a recreational place for families.

Sankengzi Ecology Park

🏡 After making an entry into Sankeng old alleys, you will soon see signs that you can follow to the destination.

Occupying an expanse of 3.8 hectares, the ecology park is endowed with a rich shoreline biodiversity and picturesque landscapes. During sunset, the park is even deeply tranquil and comfortable. The park has been fully greened and equipped with recreational facilities. It is such a nice place for tourists coming to enjoy.



Longtan Lake

🏡 Exit Freeway No. 3 via Longtan Interchange towards Longtan. Turn left on Beilong Road and keep straight to reach destination.

Longtan Lake is the most famous landmark in Longtan. After the local residents built the "Nantian Temple" here, the overall landscape has become more elegant. Furthermore, with the Longtan drawbridge and other facilities, this lake has become an important recreational place for tourists and also a site many lovers would date here.

Sankeng Old Streets

🏡 Exit Freeway No.3 at the Longtan Interchange and continue on toward Shihmen Reservoir on Tai-113th Highway. Then turn left onto the second branch of the Tai-3rd Highway and continue on until you hit Yongfu Road. Turn left and the destination is only minutes away.

Sankeng, so called "Top Town of Longtan", is an authentic Hakka village which had been a prosperous riverfront town. Now, the historic town is always crowded with tourists.



Cingciandi

Built in 1895, the time of the First Sino-Japanese War. Cingciandi in Sankengzih has a century-old history, albeit it is well-maintained. Long time ago when their homeland was stricken by famine, the ancestors of the household, the Chang family, issued a private currency, "Bronze Coins", to alleviate starvation. The coins were so credible that the emperor rewarded the Chang family and titled the house Cingciandi.



Yongfu Temple

Within its century-old history since built during Japanese regime, the temple has been reconstructed three times. Without much intricate ornament, the architecture embodies a serene and quaint majesty.



Hakka Vegi-Baozi (Dumpling)

When you come to the Sankeng old alleys, please do not miss the delicious goodies! The juicy Hakka Vegi-Baozi is made of rice and sticky rice. The filling is composed of shredded daikons, pork slices, mushrooms and dried shrimp. People's appetite could be triggered by the ambrosial gravy inside the baozi.



Niu-wen-shui (Hakka Mochi)

Alike roasted mochi in Japan, this Hakka mochi, covered with sesame seeds and peanut chips as garnish, scents fragrance of ginger. You will taste the rich, traditional Hakka flavor with every bite.

Heibaisi (Public Laundry Pond)

Located at the entrance to the Sankeng old streets, Heibaisi is a public laundry pond where locals would wash cloth and chat. A pasquinade is written on the wall next to the pond, and a bike path is nearby it as well.



Hakka Culture Center

Longyuan Temple Business District

House The range of the commercial hub spans the Longyuan Temple, Longtan Pond, and Longyuan Road neighborhood

Being the religious center of Longtan's Hakka people, the Longyuan Temple is the only one in Taiwan which enshrine the dragon and Shennong, the deity of agriculture and medicina. The historic plaza with many century-old shops located on the Longyuan Road is in front of the temple. The Hakka traditional food and creative cuisine are always served in the plaza.



Longtan Oblation Furnace

The Longtan Oblation Furnace is the most prodigious and well-maintained shrine where people used to incinerate paper with text on it. As a cultural gem, the historic relic embodies how much Hakka people in Longtan respect and treasure written characters.

Sanlin Tea Plantation

While Longtan's red soil and superb drainage befit the Paochung tea plantation, the Sanlin Leisure Tea Farm is the one with the largest scale and most well-equipped facilities. Visitors will find that orderly tea plantations in the valley with tea fragrance imbuing the air which can disperse the hustle and bustle of city life.



Shanshui Village

With rich iron in the soil, and the mild, misty, and rainy weather, tea plantations thrive in Longtan. Producing 10 percent of Taiwan's tea yield during the Japanese Regime, Longtan has been the home of high-class Paochung tea. The fragrant and full-bodied tea is the proud local specialty. It is a great gift for your friends and yourselves.

Peanut Fudge

Longtan peanut fudges and Daxi dried bean curd are tied as for the most representative specialty of Taoyuan. After many experiments and improvements, the tasty peanut fudge comes in a great variety of flavors with elegant packaging, which is why the fudge has become a popular snack nationwide.

Hakka Miso

The salty-sweet Hakka miso is a homey special that leaves an inerasable savory taste on your tongue. Handcrafted and naturally-fermented in earthenware jars, the miso could be served as a garnish or soup base.







Hot Attractions

Daxi Old Streets

- The three historical streets, Hoping Road, Zhongshan Road, and the Central Road constitute Daxi's old street area.

Daxi was the very beginning of Taoyuan. Many merchants and companies had been created here. The historic streets like Hoping Road and Zhongshan Road are full of buildings in the style of Asia-Europe fusion. Nowadays, the streets are packed with shops and teemed with tourists on holidays. This place is also the home of many attractions like Zhongzheng Park, Wude Temple, Daxi Art Villa, the former residence of singer Fong Fei Fei, the back alley labyrinth, Daxi Bridge, Wood Art & Ecology Museum and the Chinese gate ways as well as snack bars. The historic streets are deserving of your visit.



Daxi Bridge

Daxi Bridge is embellish with Baroque style, the bridge has become a stage for street artists on holidays. At nights the bridge is covered by splendid lighting, and transforms into the most gorgeous nightscape above the Dahan Creek.

Heping Road

The road is packed with shops and delis selling a variety of goodies, including dried bean curd and peanut fudges, sweet potato pancakes and coffee etc. Go through the road, and you will find your favorite on this road. It is worth your long stay.

Zhongshan Road

The luxurious houses built during Japanese regime line on both side of the road. The delicate houses' facade in classic style combined with western custom spread the aura of nostalgia.

Wude Temple

Built in 1935, the Wude Temple is a traditional Japanese building where policemen used to practice Kendo and Judo. It is paired with the Assembly Hall in Daxi Artist Villa, while the former embodies eastern exoticness, the later western. They are referred to as "The Japanese and Western Duo" and forms a delightful contrast.

Daxi Artist Villa

Daxi Artist Villa nearby Zhongzheng Park has been designed as an art park. It includes the historic Town Union, a gallery, an art studio and a garden. In addition, there is also an outdoor café which shows extraordinary vista over the Dahan Creek.

Daxi Woodart Ecomuseum

Daxi has a large number of Japanese-style wooden dormitories. In the early days, they were living quarters of elementary teachers and policemen. Now, they have become new spots for cultural preservation after repair and reinterpretation.



The Culture Resort of the Jiang

Daxi, Taoyuan has been called "The Town of Presidents", due to two President Chiang had lived in Daxi and Touliao with spectacular scenery. Now, Culture Resort of the Jiang has been integrated with Daxi Mausoleum, Cihu Presidential Burial Place, Cihu Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Sculpture Park, Back Cihu, and the Baiji Tree-Shade Foot Trail then formed a spot with history, culture, recreation, and ecology to be a new attraction.

Daxi Mausoleum

Inside the mausoleum, there is only a simple office and altar for paying respects to Ex-president Chiang Ching-Kuo. The humble furnishings reflect his stand of simplicity. The Cihu Presidential Burial Place is about a kilometer away, the two are connected by the Yeh-Ling footpath. And the beautiful scenery along the way makes it a pleasurable walk.

Cihu Presidential Burial Place

The Presidential Burial Place is renowned for entombing Ex-president Chiang Kai-Shek who occupied this place as a villa because it is alike his hometown Fenghua, Zhejiang. The name of the lake ,Cihu literally means the Lake of Benevolence which was named by Chiang Kai-Shek to memorize his mother. The honor guards changing ceremony with rifle spinning performance and the natural environment are the big attractions here.



Cihu Memorial Sculpture Park

The park is strewn with more than a hundred Chiang Kai-Shek sculptures donated by various institutions nationwide, and offers a great opportunity to see Chiang Kai-Shek sculptures in various postures and designs.

Rear Cihu

The lake is endowed with rich biodiversity, and visitors can easily spot spiders, birds, frogs, and other animals while walking on its wooded trails in a forest full of seldom-seen white birches and Taiwan incense cedars.

Gourmet Foods

Dried Bean Curd

The best-selling souvenir, dried bean curd, undergoes stewing and quick-freezing alternately for at least 4 repetitions for the delicacy's al dente texture, full-bodied aroma, and savory taste. It was said that in the old days, due to lack of better preservation methods, if the dried bean curd was not sold out in the morning, it would spoil in the afternoon. Thus, the locals' ancestors conceived a new recipe in which caramelized brown sugar was added as a garnish and a natural coloring while bean curd was stewing. The inspiration resulted in a more attractive appearance, longer preservation, and enriched, multileveled flavor.

Nowadays, visitors can easily see many dried bean curd vendors on Daxi streets. The delicacy has become the most celebrated specialty of Daxi.



Fuxing Indigenous Mountain Recreation

Gifted with rich and precious natural resources, the Fuxing District is the mountain region with great landscape in northern Taiwan. Moreover, both well-endowed natural and cultural assets make it a paradise for travelers. Among its celebrated attractions are Lala Mountain, Xiaowulai scenic area, the Jiaobanshan Villa, and Dongyan Mountain Forest Recreation Area. The famous products growing on this ground are the white peaches, bamboo shoots, mushrooms and poinsettias.

Sanmin Bat Cave

Occupying an expanse nearly a thousand hectares, the Dongyanshan Forest Park is the largest one in northern Taiwan. As its cedar forest is home to many birds, insects and floras, it is a great choice for family outings and ecological education field trips.

It is said that in 1886, Liu Minchuan, the governor of Taiwan during Chin Dynasty saw the mountain peak like a horn and the creek bed as flat as a board in this place. Thus the name "Jiao Ban Mountain" was given. (Jiao means horn, and Ban means board).

Afterward, late resident Chiang Kai Shek found that the place is alike his home Chi Kou Town of Fung Hua County, Zhejiang Province, China. So he named the river terrace beneath the mountain "Chi Kou Platform Land". Because he liked this land and scenery so much, he built his chateau there.



Camphor Reservation Area

During the period as a colony of Japan, the camphor industry for export in Fuxing District was prosperous. The camphor storage was built for keeping and vending camphor. The decaying old building remarks the glorious history of Fuxing District.

Pine Pavilion

This was one of the favorite chateaus of the late President Chiang Kai Shek. The view through the pavilion "Parents on Mind" is spectacular and alike Chi Kou Town, former president Chiang's home town. When Chiang Kai Shek passed away, his son, late president Chiang Jin Kuo mourned his father and declared "Mourning the Parents in Mei Tai".

Jiaobanshan Refuge Trail


By the word-of-mouth from Chiang Kai Shek's guards, the evacuation footpath has been exposed. This footpath through a tunnel had been built as a emergency path connecting to Da-Han Creek in case the main roads were blocked in war.

Meiyuan, the Plum Garden

During the winter, hundreds of plum blossom in Meiyuan would tint the surrounding in a silver white world gorgeous and alluring.

Eco Pool

With the environment connected by water and surrounding wooden footpath, Ecol Pool has been built as a waterfront park for ecological education.



Xiaowulai Scenic Area


Xiaowulai Waterfall

As the murmuring upper reach of Xiaowulai Waterfall gallops off the sharp cliff and forms a cascade, the water blooms into the finest droplets and hangs drapes of dancing mist colored by a rainbow. It is such a mesmerizing scenery.



Waterzone Garden

Perfect for a family outing and splashing about, the garden offers a cool respite from summer heat. Visitors could easily spot damselflies, tadpoles, fish and shrimp in this ecological treasure house inciting children's exploratory spirit. (Open from June to September each year.)



Universal Observatory

Surrounded by a far reaching and picturesque view of mountains, the tourists could see Xiaowulai Waterfall, Skywalk, and maroon Luofu Bridge from the observatory.

Forest Breath Footpath



Forest Breath Footpath is next to the Skywalk on a uphill. Treading on the footpath, visitors could see the skywalk and Xiaowulai Waterfall. Furthermore, the footpath connects to Xiaowulai Mountain.

Xiaowulai Skywalk



Xiaowulai Skywalk was designed as a plain geometric structure with tempered glass. The skywalk is stretched out 11 m horizontally from the 70 m high cliff. When standing on the glass bridge, visitors can enjoy an all range view of the spectacular Xiaowulai Waterfall. This is the hottest spot in Fuxing.

Waterway Archaic Path

The waterway next to the Waterway Archaic Path was a vital irrigation channel which fed the whole farming area of Luofu in the past, but it has lost its functions today. Let's have a history trip along the waterway through the Luofu Bridge to the riverfront.



Yishing Suspension Bridge

The 201-meter long bridge has began to gather steam after the crew of the movie, *Warriors of the Rainbow: Seediq Bale* filmed some scenes here.

Fuxing Bridge

The 150 m long Fuxing Bridge is the first grand-scale, cable-stayed suspension bridge in Taiwan. Spanning high above the beautiful Dahan Creek, it integrates both transportation and observatory functions with its footpath and balcony.

Luofu Bridge

The over 230 m long Luofu Bridge is an arterial way of the Northern Cross-Island Highway. The bridge shares traffic with the Fuxing Bridge and reaches to the Shihmen Reservoir, Jiaoban Mountain, Lala Mountain, and Baling, Chilan, and Mingchih.

Baling Bridge

Lalashan Bailing Trail Eco Park




With its ecological diversity, Lalashan has recently become a very popular spot for outdoor lecture of schools. The tourist center has a butterfly house, geological museum, an eco exploring bridge which is hung high within the trees. Students could closely observe ecology in tree crown layer, experience the wilderness in the mountains and

enjoy the very different view of the nature. Also, the Ba Lin Trail provides a place where people could reminisce the aborigines' history and go sightseeing. It is a spectacular trail.

Butterfly House

As the diverse forestry of Lala Mountain cradles abundant butterfly species. The park is a well-known butterfly-watching paradise in northern Taiwan. In this place people could understand the butterfly and ecology in Lalashan.



Beetle House

Lalashan is a beneficial habitat for many beetles with its prosperous forest. In the Beetle House, visitors could learn the various stages a beetle goes through in its lifetime.

Geological museum


Offering geology information of Lalashan, visitors could observe and learn about geological actions which have taken place beneath their feet.

Broad-Leaf Forest Information Center

At the top of Lala Mountain, as the old-growth forest remains primeval. The mixed-coniferous-broad-leaf forest is the home of millennium-old giant trees. Visitors could know more about Lala Mountain's forestry through the explicit illustrations in the center.

Lalashan Natural Reserve Area

Since 1986 Lalashan Natural Reserve was set up, the reserve has been the home of 24 designated giant trees, ranging from 500 to 3000 years old. Among them, the 2800-year-old giant tree Number 5 is the eldest one.



Yeheng Terrace Fields

Yeheng Terrace Fields, where there is an Atayal tribe, is nearby southwest Baling. It is famous for its terraces and hot springs. Many photography experts have visited the village to capture the terrace landscape, and the across-river Sanguang village is the best place to shoot the pictures. The terrace fields were built during Japanese Regime for growing rice. It had more than 1200 terraces over 1000 m high during its prime time. Today, the locals grow vegetables and fruits here.



Three Turtle Valley

Yufeng creek, the upper reach of Dahan creek, and the Sanguang creek flow through valleys then merge into Dahan creek at Xiaobaling. Looking down the creeks from a distance on a mountain road, the overlapped valleys are like three turtle heads, and the mountains are similar to turtles' back. So it is called "Three Turtle Valley". This is one of the representatives of Lalashan.

Kala Tribe

"Kala" means "branches" in Atayal language. Located on a mountainside nearby the Lalashan Natural Reserve Area, the tribe is somewhere the tourists must pass before entering the reserve area. There are many cultural heritages in the tribe. The most impressive one is the Ark-like Gala Church which seems the God's shelter harboring on the mountain.


